The 'Cultural Networks at Work (CNaW)' Conference takes place in the beautiful premises of the Flagey located on the Place Sainte-Croix in 1050 Brussels.

In 1938 the Flagey building, the former broadcasting building designed by the Belgian architect Joseph Diongre, was inaugurated. The inherent qualities of the studios were praised throughout the world and attracted the most prestigious musicians of the century (classical, contemporary and jazz) for concerts, festivals and recordings.

The Flagey's mission is to be a unique and multidisciplinary audiovisual centre, dedicated to artistic creations and encounters: an international meeting place that brings life to a city full of creativity.
