July 18-20, 2018

What?

A study visit for a delegation of EUROCITIES (max. 25 participants) and EFA (European Festival Association (max 25 participants) to Leeuwarden – Friesland European Capital of Culture 2018.

Focus of the study visit

Get inspired on using cultural events as a driver for:

- Awareness for the surroundings we live in.
 - Addressing the importance of a balanced ecology by culture.
 - How to organize festivals eco-friendly?

(example projects: King of the Meadows, Silence of the Bees, Welcome to the Village)

- Innovation. How to use festivals as temporary mini-societies to test and stimulate innovation? (example project: Innofest);
- Socio-economic change: cultural education and events as a driver for inclusion and participation. How can we make culture accessible for everybody: young, old, rich, poor, new inhabitants, people outside the city (example projects: Adje, Look@me!).

Objectives of the study visit

- Share knowledge on the role of local authorities (facilities, licenses, finance, infrastructure) in fostering sustainability through cultural events
- Learn from the hosts city and other guests (city and festival experts) how projects are implemented at local level
- Share experience, challenges and results with peers from all over Europe

Outcomes of the study visit

Recommendations to cities will be developed based on the conclusions of the study visit

Why does Leeuwarden want to invite members of EUROCITIES and EFA?

- To learn from partner-cities and events on specific topics (see: focus of the study visit).
- The year 2018 gives us the opportunity to show what Leeuwarden Friesland offers in the field of culture.
- The 'Innofest *1' project appeals to several international events and EUROCITIES-members.
 The same goes for Cultural projects that address climate/environment issues such as King of the Meadows.

- Vice versa is the European network of EUROCITIES and EFA of interest for the entrepreneurs and start-ups participating in Innofest. It offers them a European stage to promote their innovations.
- To strengthen the position of Leeuwarden Friesland with these networks (getting a better position enhances the chance to be considered a partner in possible European projects).
